

# ResponsibleAg Certification Program

## Significant Issues

April 7, 2023

ResponsibleAg has identified the following eight issues that, if discovered during an assessment, would require immediate attention and would prevent the facility from achieving certification until such time as the issue, or issues have been addressed. Once corrected, the facility would resume normal participation in the assessment and certification process.

Additional documentation is required to substantiate compliance with each of the following eight issues. Proof of submission, photo documentation or an on-site visit by an independent ResponsibleAg Verification Auditor, as deemed appropriate by ResponsibleAg, is required to prove the issue, or issues have been corrected.
